NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 Races will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020*.
- 1.2 RRS 40 is changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear life jacket or other adequate personal flotation device while racing.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Members in good standing of the following classes who are also members of the YRA are invited to participate: ALERION EXPRESS, BEAR, BIRD, CAL 20, FOLKBOAT, IOD, KNARR, and SANTANA 22.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter electronically through the YRA website (above)..

3.0 FEES

- 3.1 Entry Fees are as follows:
 - 3.1.1. Full Series Registrants (all 6 race days): \$240.00
 - 3.1.2. 5 Race Day Registrants: \$200.00
 - 3.1.3. 4 Race Day Registrants: \$160.00
 - 3.1.4. 3 Race Day Registrants: \$120.00
 - 3.1.5. 2 Race Day Registrants: \$80.00
 - 3.1.6. Single Race Day Registrants: \$40.00
- 3.2 A one-time \$50 YRA Membership Fee will be assessed when registering if a member's YRA Membership is not current.
- 3.3 The entry fees paid by boats in classes not meeting the minimum number of timely entrants for any race under paragraph 5.2 will be returned

4.0 MANAGEMENT

- 4.1 Each race shall be under the management of a race committee of the sponsoring yacht club.
- 4.2 Sponsoring Yacht Clubs, Class Officers, and CBRA Officers, are listed in Appendix A.

5.0 SCHEDULE AND RACING VENUES

- 5.1 Dates, first warning signal, and venues are as follows:

- 5.2 Otherwise eligible boats in each class must number four or more entrants by 5 PM on the Wednesday preceding any race, to receive a start for that race.

6.0 MINIMUM EQUIPMENT LIST

Boats must comply with the United States Coast Guard's requirements for recreational vessels, which have been incorporated in the YRA Equipment Requirements, at <http://yra.org/yra-racing/safety-requirements/>

7.0 SCORING

- 7.1 RRS A9 will apply in each instance in which it is inconsistent with RRS A4.2.
7.2 For the purposes of qualifying the fleet for the season, a race that is abandoned shall be listed as a valid race for any boat that came to the starting area.

8.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 Sailing instructions, notices to competitors, and changes to the sailing instructions, including limiting entrants pursuant to paragraph 5.2, will be posted on the YRA website, www.yra.org.

9.0 COMMUNICATIONS

- 9.1 On-the-water radio communication between the Race Committee and racing boats will be allowed on the VHF channel specified in the sailing instructions

10.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
