Make sure to reserve your meals by June 27 at 1500. Some walk-in meals will be sold at the registration desk.

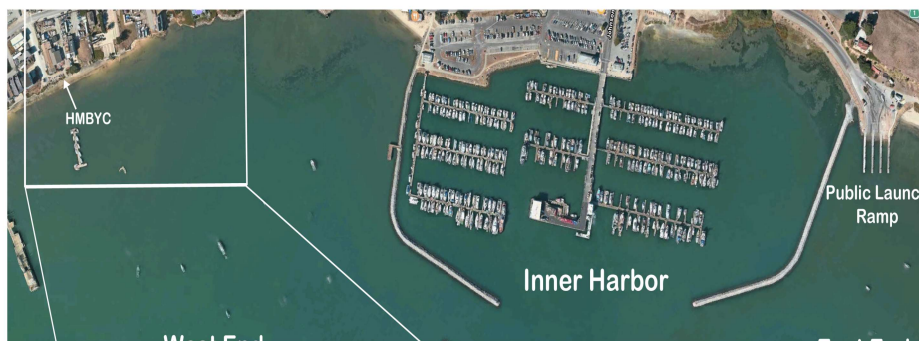

Anchoring and Harbor Slips

Anchoring on Arrival

For anchoring, we recommend you anchor in the area marked “West End.” Watch your depth as you go further west in the harbor, as it gets quite shallow.

A **shore boat service** will ferry people from/to anchored boats and the club on Saturday from 1530–2145 and Sunday 0700-1000. The shore boat service will monitor **VHF channel 69** for pickup requests.



Slips may be available at the Marina

Contact the Harbormaster anytime on the day on Saturday at 650/726-4382 or on VHF 74. Transient slips are on an as-available basis. Tell the Harbormaster if you are willing to raft to other race boats.

Use of the Floating Dock Ferry

People love our home-grown ferry that connects our floating dock to the beach. Our shore boat service will drop you on our dock, and you will take the ferry into shore.

You will find a call button on the dock, operating buttons on the ferry, and another call button on the shore. Hold the button to move the ferry. In the event of a power problem, ferry will be operated by pulling on the ferry lines directly.

- **Ferry head count limit is 5 people.** Please respect this limit.
- **Move the ferry off the beach after use** to prevent grounding as the tide goes out - otherwise you and others may not be able to get back to your boats!
