Base Rating of 66 updated to indicate it is for a Elan 40 DK This boat: +3 sec/mi for 105% hs As Sailed: 69 DW Rating: 593</p>

Displacement was updated to reflect additional weight of permanent items like windlass and batteries and DW rating was recalculated.
